American Geophysical Union awards CRREL-IGERT trainee

The AGU recently announced that Chris Polashenski, Thayer School of Engineering, Dartmouth College and CRREL-mentored student was selected to receive an Outstanding Student Paper Award for his presentation, 'The Fresh Meltwater in the Sea Ice System' at the Union's 2010 Fall Meeting.
